

## ■ Atacama Evoque 60-40 SE2 £200 per shelf

**Atacama has made** a whole host of tweaks to its Award-winning hi-fi rack to serve up another class-leading product.

The most obvious difference is that the bamboo shelves on the SE2 version have curved sides. This helps to reduce the build-up of internal standing waves, something reinforced by the revised shaping of the cut-outs on the underside.

To deal with vibrations, each leg is decoupled from the shelf it is attached to, and has an internally mounted

weight that controls resonance. They are terminated by a rounded brass spikes for a degree of grounding between layers.

We're struck by how much more agile and dynamic our electronics sound when used on the Atacama. We're aware of more detail, coupled with greater separation between dense instrumental strands. Dynamic expression, precision and rhythmic coherence are better too.

If you want to hear just how good your system can sound, it's worth the money.
